Senator Paul S. Sarbanes River Access Trail—Jennings Randolph Lake

The Senator Paul S. Sar-banes River Access Trail is approximately a two hour round trip hike that extends from the Maryland Overlook to the bank of the North Branch of the Potomac River. The trail meanders across open fields through deciduous woodlands and ends on the river's edge.

wildlife and vegetation. Take binoculars for bird watching or a fishing rod and test your skill!
